



# ACCOMMODATION FOR STUDY ABROAD STUDENTS


Great accommodation options for students joining the Study Abroad Programme at Reading



- **Study periods.** We have full year and partyear contracts available with entry points in September 2017 and January 2018.
- Variety of room types available to suit your budget from Premium en-suite rooms to rooms with shared bathrooms\*
- Catered and self-catered hall options giving you the flexibility about how and when you eat
- **Great location** all accommodation is located either on the main Whiteknights campus or within easy walking distance

- All inclusive rent includes utility bills, Wi-Fi, basic contents insurance, maintenance and communal cleaning

# **HOW TO APPLY**

- 1 You can apply for accommodation via the personal applicant portal www.reading.ac.uk/applicantportal after you have accepted the official offer of a place on the Study Abroad Programme
- 2 Application deadlines:
  - 1 August if you are starting your course in September
  - 1 December if you are starting your course in January
- 3 If you are registering for the programme for the full academic year (September – June) we will be able to make you an offer of accommodation once your academic offer is unconditional
- 4 If you are coming for less than a full academic year you will be notified from mid-August onwards (September start) or December (January start)
- 5 At the time of accepting an accommodation offer you will be asked to pay a deposit of £250

### Accommodation contract dates

**Block 1** 15/16/17 September 2017 to 31 December 2017

Block 2 1 January 2018 to 22/23/24 June (depending on the hall you are moving into)
